**NATIONAL SUPPLEMENT
TO OFFICIAL RULE 6.0 MEMORIALS**

14 January 2006

6.1 Submission of Printed Copies

Teams shall format and print their memorials on standard letter size paper (8 ½" x 11"). Memorials should be spiral bound. Each memorial shall have two (2) front cover pages (i.e., an outside front cover and an inside front cover). The Applicant Memorial should have an outside front and back cover of light blue. The Respondent Memorial should have an outside front and back cover of light red. The inside front cover page shall be plain white paper just like the other parts of the memorial. Both outside and inside front covers shall contain the same information required under 6.6.1. of the Official Rules.

6.2 Mailing of Memorials

Each Team shall:

- (a) submit ten (10) printed copies of its Applicant Memorial and ten (10) printed copies of its Respondent Memorial to the National Administrator, postmarked no later than Wednesday, 17 January 2007;
- (b) send Memorials via the two-day or faster delivery service of DHL, LBC, JRS, or similar express mail service. In order to confirm proper date of mailing, each parcel containing Memorials must bear a courier-issued postmark, tracking label, or other indication of the date of mailing;
- (c) address the parcel to:

- (d) text (sms) the tracking number or code to the National Administrator through Mobile No. 0920-9387440;

6.3 Disputes

In the event of a dispute, the sending Team bears the burden of demonstrating that its Memorials were appropriately addressed and were timely and properly mailed. Teams should retain their mailing receipt as proof of the date of mailing.
